Her love of animals, family, and children's storytelling led to the creation of Nola Red's Little Paws Big Steps Foundation, a charitable organization dedicated to promoting children's literacy, anti-bullying and acceptance initiatives, educational opportunities, and veterinary assistance for rescue dogs in need.
